Langley Castle works closely with Tynedale Council in recycling as much waste as possible, we have a bottle skip on site and have regular collections of all other items.

Please place any recyclable items beside any bin for collection by your housekeeper.

Items we can recycle on your behalf.

- Glass bottles
- Plastic Bottles
- Aerosols

Some of the other things we do....

Langley uses a water purification system so to reduce the amount of recycled bottles, and it also reduces bottles being transported on the roads.

Energy saving light bulbs have been replaced in 65% of our light fittings, with more planned.

The entire heating system has been changed to low energy boilers that run efficiently.

Where possible we use local businesses; craftsmen (plumbers, joiners and electricians). Food items are sourced from local farms and suppliers.

Phosphate-free soaps & detergents are available in guest rooms, and chlorines are not used for cleaning.

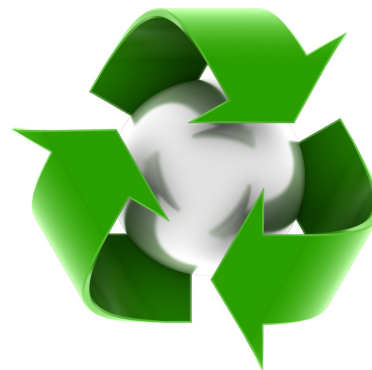
